



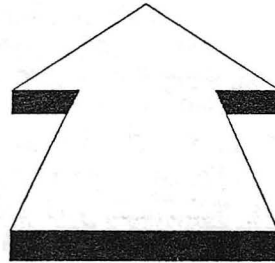

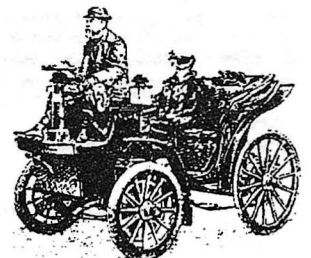
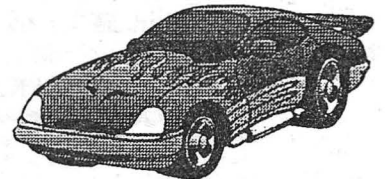

The cruise will conclude at the Museum of Pioneer History in Chandler with the dedication of the third exhibit.

There will be a quiz game to play looking for clues as the cruise progresses. Prizes will be awarded at each of the exhibits openings with the closing ceremony to be held in Tighlman Park in Chandler.
