## **ACTION ALERT! YOUR HELP NEEDED NOW!**

City of Bethany may tear down the historic Western Motel

Your help is needed right away to prevent the city of Bethany from making a terrible mistake.

According to a report from the *Daily Oklahoman*, the city council declared the motel at 7600 NW 39th (Route 66) a public nuisance after receiving complaints about prostitution there. The newspaper reported that a motel manager was arrested in a prostitution sting operation.

Nuisance abatement often involves demolition of the property. We need to make sure city leaders realize that the building — which was constructed in 1953, and which is known for the neon cowboy hat on its sign out front — is not to blame for its owner's failings.

If a person driving a 1953 Ford were arrested for DUI, would the city crush the car? Of course not! Why tear down a 1953 motel just because some people staying there have chosen to flout the law?

Please call the mayor and city council at (405) 789-5005 and politely explain that tearing down a historic motel is not an acceptable solution to this problem. Encourage them to seek a more responsible approach — such as better law enforcement, new ownership, or adaptive reuse —that will keep the building standing.

Take just a few moments to make this very important phone call. You could be instrumental in the prevention of a disaster like the one that occurred in Vinita last month, when Scott Moore, the owner of C.R. Moore Co., a Vinita Chrysler dealership, made the inexplicable decision to tear down the historic Spraker Service Station.

The cottage-style Conoco station, which had been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1995, appeared to be in good condition, although Sharon Moore, dealer trade coordinator for C.R. Moore Co., told Ron Warnick of Route66News.com that "It would take \$10,000 to fix up that building."

That sounds like a lot of money until you consider the fact that during my brief career as a car salesman, I sold a car that netted more than \$10,600 in profits for my employer. That's ONE CAR. And it wasn't the most expensive car on the lot, either. Not by a long shot.

Fortunately, not all the news on the preservation front is bad. Warnick reported in November that the Round Barn in Arcadia was getting a \$21,000

facelift, and in October, he reported that the City of Tulsa Board of Adjustment had unanimously classified the Meadow Gold sign as a historic monument, clearing the way for it to be restored and put up in a new location on Route 66.

The sign had to be taken down two years ago after another Chrysler dealer, Chris Nikel, decided to tear down the building on which it sat — and then proceeded to do absolutely nothing with the property for a year before moving his business out of Tulsa altogether.

Warnick writes, "There was a smidge of concern whether the Meadow Gold sign would be able to conform to the city's zoning code, especially since the sign could be considered outdoor advertising."

The classification of the sign as a historic monument eliminates that concern.

And on another positive note, two sections of Route 66 have been added to the National Register of Historic Places.

In late September, the Associated Press reported that the Tank Farm Loop near Kellyville and the 1926 truss bridge over Pryor Creek near Chelsea, both on older alignments of Route 66, were added to the National Register. Directions to both segments can be found in the Oklahoma Route 66 Association Trip Guide and in Jim Ross' book *Oklahoma Route* 66.

## Runners take to the road

Route 66 Association members helped man aid stations at Davenport, Depew, Kellyville and Sapulpa to support participants in the recent Mother Road 100, a 100-mile ultramarathon extending from Arcadia to Sapulpa in honor of the 80th anniversary of Route 66. Runners started at the Round Barn and ended up at Carl's Jr. in Sapulpa, following older alignments of 66 when possible. The race began at 7 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 11, and runners had 30 hours to complete the course. Oklahoma Route 66 enthusiast John Hargrove of Arcadia was one of the athletes who completed the difficult course, which was made more difficult by frigid nighttime temperatures.

The race was one of three Route 66-themed foot races in November. On Nov. 19, the inaugural Route 66 Marathon and Half-Marathon were run in Tulsa. The race began and ended at 6th and Main in downtown Tulsa. Part of the course ran along 11th Street and Southwest Boulevard — both part of Route 66 — before following the Arkansas River south to Jenks and then coming back through Brookside.

On Nov. 25, runners followed Kansas' stretch of Route 66 on foot during the annual half-marathon "Race Across Kansas."

Emily Priddy, eastern vice-president of the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, is organizing a training program that includes some runs along Route 66 for anyone who would like to run a marathon next year. Anyone at any level of fitness is invited to participate.

Mother Road 100 organizer Thomas Hill, who also organizes the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon, is offering first-time marathoners a chance to make the OKC race their first marathon and help Route 66 at the same time. He will waive the entry fee for the race for first-timers who make a donation to help with Route 66 preservation. 
