Many Roadies come to the Festival to see the booths, attend the Summit meetings, and go to the Awards Banquet.


In addition to these activities that take place annually at the Route 66 Festival, Clinton is boasting some unique events to add to the festivities.




SIGNAGE General Information



Both meetings will be held at 2 p.m. at the Oklahoma Tourism Information Center, 122nd Street & I-35 in Oklahoma City.






