Local hotels are sold out for the Festival weekend, and lodging in nearby communities is filling up quickly. The newly opened Clinton Hampton Inn serves as the event's host hotel.

Many Roadies come to the Festival to see the booths, attend the Summit meetings, and go to the Awards Banquet.

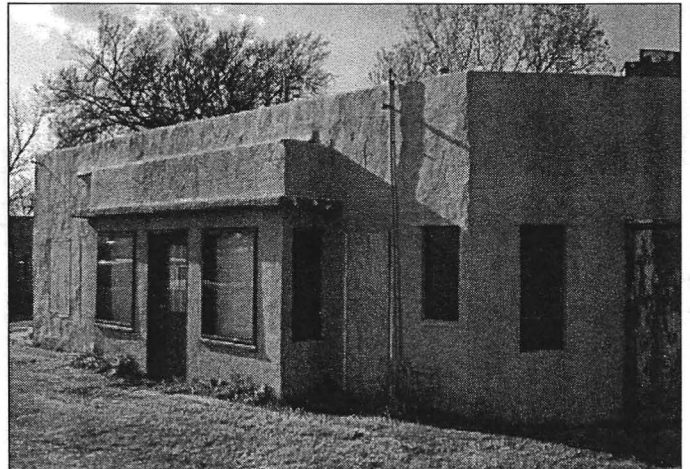
In addition to these activities that take place annually at the Route 66 Festival, Clinton is boasting some unique events to add to the festivities.

### Join us for a preservation project!

Festivalgoers will have a unique opportunity to work side-by-side with volunteers from across the country and around the world — including bestselling author and Pixar voice talent Michael Wallis and other Route 66 notables — as the Oklahoma Route 66 Association holds a special preservation project in conjunction with the festival.

We will be doing grassroots, hands-on preservation work at the former Ray's Motel, 720 S. 8th St. in Clinton.

Work sessions will be held from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday, June 22, and from 8:30 a.m. to dusk Saturday, June 23, and Sunday, June 24. Work clothes and gloves are recommended. No special skills are required.

From the Frisco Center — where many of the festival events are taking place — go south on Hwy. 183 (also South Fourth Street) for 5.5 blocks. Follow the Y to the right (west) around a curve. Watch on the right side for 8th Street.

# CUSTER & WASHITA COUNTIES

The maps on these pages were taken from the 2007 *Oklahoma Route 66 Association Trip Guide*, which is hot off the press and will be distributed at the Oklahoma Route 66 Association's booth at the National Route 66 Festival in Clinton and at member businesses across the state. We have included the maps and directions for Custer and Washita counties here to help festivalgoers who are interested in exploring the Mother Road in and around Clinton.

We hope all our members will be able to come out for the festival. While you're in town, be sure to visit the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum, participate in the preservation work being conducted at Ray's Motel (details appear on the first page of this newsletter), and stop by the Association booth at the authors' and artists' expo.

If you have time to explore, head over to Weatherford to see the new Heartland of America Heritage Cener, 2000 E. Frontage Road. To get there, take Exit 82 or 84 and follow the south access road. The road winds around quite a bit. Stay with it to see this fascinating new museum, which features exhibits on everything from wars to pharmacies.



## SIGNAGE

### General Information

In Washita County, there are no alternate highway signs to watch for. In Custer County, Business 40 is valid for the eastern part of Clinton and most of Weatherford. In between towns in Custer County, the route has no official designation at all.

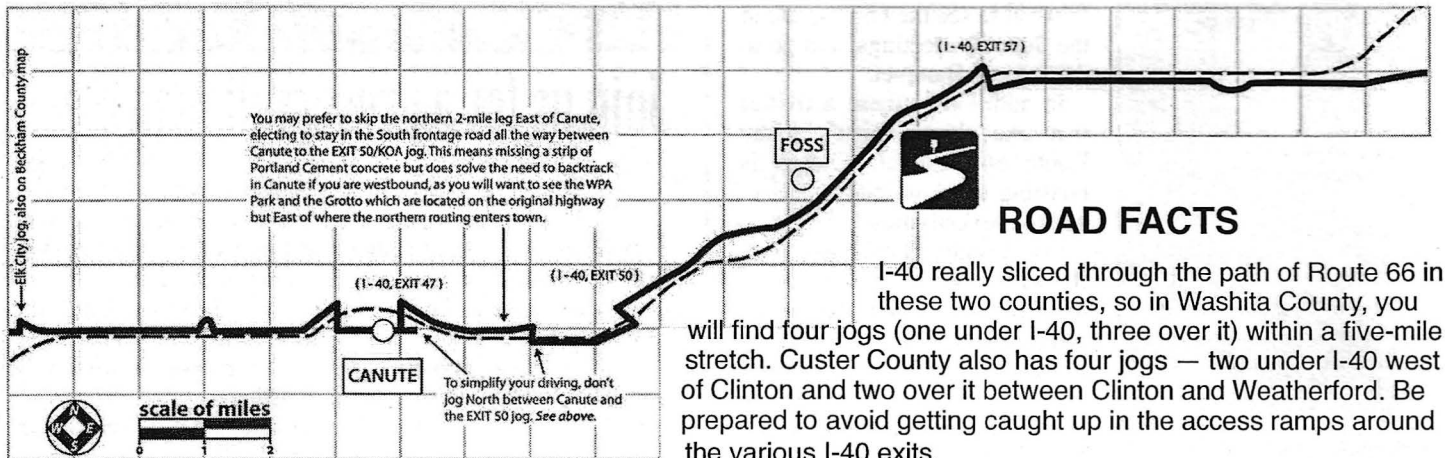

## ROAD FACTS

I-40 really sliced through the path of Route 66 in these two counties, so in Washita County, you will find four jogs (one under I-40, three over it) within a five-mile stretch. Custer County also has four jogs — two under I-40 west of Clinton and two over it between Clinton and Weatherford. Be prepared to avoid getting caught up in the access ramps around the various I-40 exits.

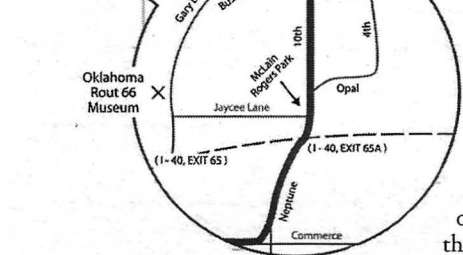
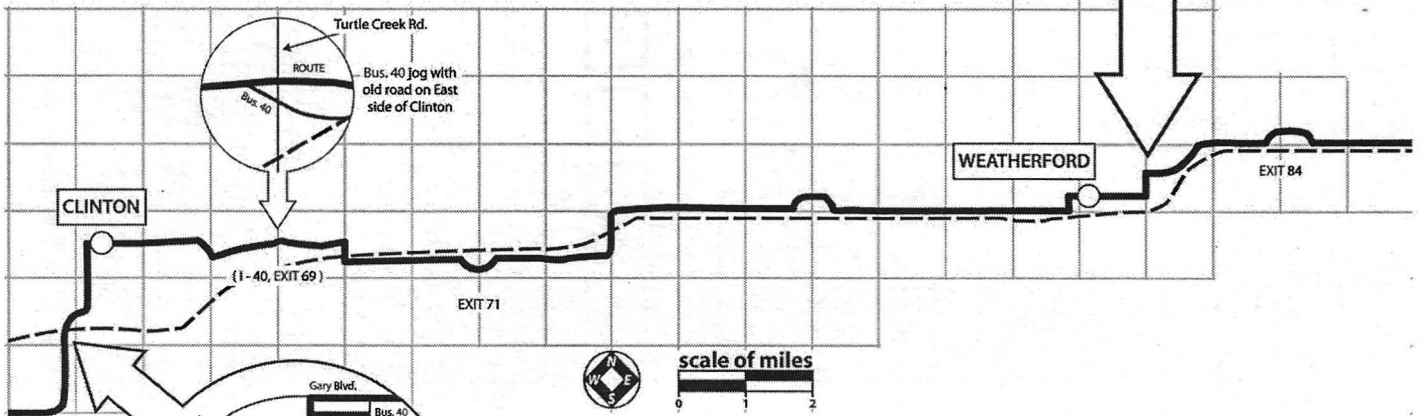

## ROAD HIGHLIGHTS

See if you can find the following landmarks, listed in no particular order:

- Cherokee Trading Post.
- A steel truss single arch bridge.
- Two tiny old motor court cabins between Canute and Foss.
- KOA Campgrounds.
- Row of big shade trees down below an I-40 jog, indicating where the road originally tracked.

- Drive-in movie theater west of Weatherford.
- VW Beetle on monster wheels.
- The 1830s lost Mexican gold mining town of Cascorillo between Canute and Clinton. If you find it, you are doing better than anybody else. Tales that this place might exist set off a gold rush in 1895. Little gold was found, and no trace of the town was ever discovered.



## CLINTON

Clinton is brimming with Route 66 mania, largely because for some 28 years, the post-World War II National Highway 66 Association was headquartered here. Although that organization disbanded in the 1980s, the city is now home to the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum, the first state-sponsored Route 66 museum in the nation.

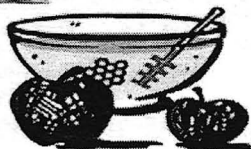

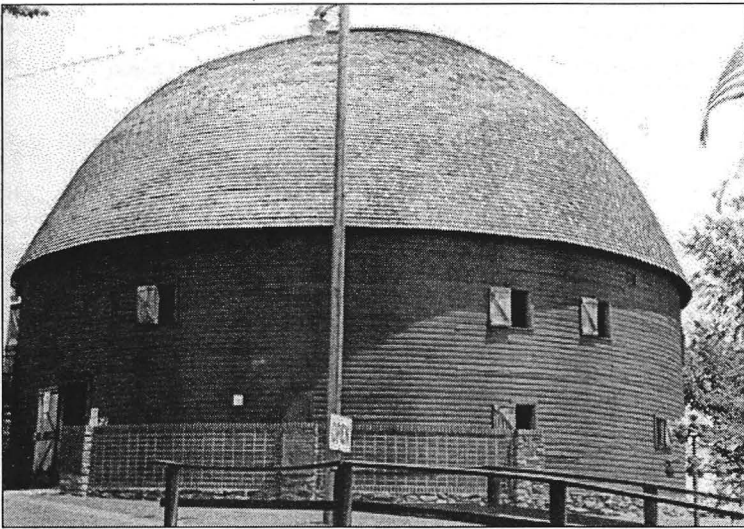
