Clinton's Route 66 festival a success

Oklahomans take home four of the top six honors at the banquet

Oklahoma took the lion's share of the awards during the Will Rogers Awards Evening, held June 22 in conjunction with the National Route 66 Festival in Clinton. Chandler's Old Armory received the Cyrus Avery Award for historic preservation, while Marian Clark of Tulsa was named Person of the Year, and Route 66 Harley-Davidson — a strong supporter of the Oklahoma Route 66 Association — took home the Business of the Year award.

The Will Rogers Award — whose recipient is selected by the Rogers family — went to Route 66 author and historian Michael Wallis of Tulsa.

Texans Delbert and Ruth Trew won the Lifetime Achievement Award, while David and Mary Lou Knudson of the National Historic Route 66 Federation received the Founders' Award.

Other honors went to Nora Mansfield, a longtime waitress at the late Pop Hicks Restaurant, and the board of directors for the First National Bank of Shamrock, Texas, who donated the historic U-Drop Inn gas station and cafe to the city a few years ago.

The building, which served as the model for Ramone's body shop in the film *Cars*, was restored in 2003 and is home to the Shamrock Chamber of Commerce.

The historic Ray's Motel, located at 720 S. 8th St., on the truck route alignment of 66 in Clinton, came out a winner that weekend as about two dozen volunteers descended on the property with scrapers and paintbrushes to give the building that once housed the

office a much-needed facelift.

Volunteers from as close as the other side of town and as far away as Canada spent three days scraping the once-gray building and giving it a coat of gleaming white paint.

The effort drew the attention of area media outlets, including the *Clinton Daily News*, *Daily Oklahoman*, and KOKH-TV of Oklahoma City.

Aurora, Colo.

The owner of Route 66 Root Beer also stopped by with root beer for the volunteers.

In addition to the awards presentation and the preservation project, the festival included a special breakfast for members of the Route 66 Yahoo! group (online at <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/route66>); a 5K run; a golf tournament; an art show; exhibits by Route 66 authors, artists, organizations, and collectors; food and crafts vendors; children's activities; fireworks; museum tours; and many other activities.

The biggest winner of the weekend may have been the city of Clinton itself.

Erin Adams, Clinton Chamber of Commerce president and chairwoman for the festival, reports that the event was good for business that weekend.

"Our restaurants were very busy, and hotels were all full. Mike Robinson, the longtime owner of our Dairy Queen, said that he had planned ahead and had extra food and extra help, but he still had to close an hour early because he ran out of food," Adams told *Route66News.com*.

"It was his best day EVER for sales."

Adams also reported that the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum had 1,200 visitors on the Saturday of the festival — six times the number it draws on an average day.

Next year's festival will be held June 18-22 in Litchfield, Ill.

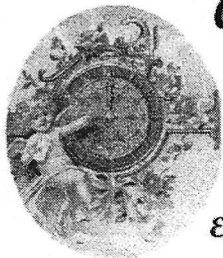

The New Heartland Museum in Weatherford is now open. The museum includes over 80 special booths and displays, veterans displays from all wars, a working blacksmith shop, and an authentic, furnished Little Red one-room school house (made available to special grade school groups).

Hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday and 1 to 5 p.m. Sunday. Admission is \$5 for adults and \$2 for children ages 13 to 18. On Father's and Mother's Day, admission is free to fathers and mothers, and admission is free to all veterans on Veterans Day. Special rates are available for bus groups and other special groups.

Association to offer fall museum cruise

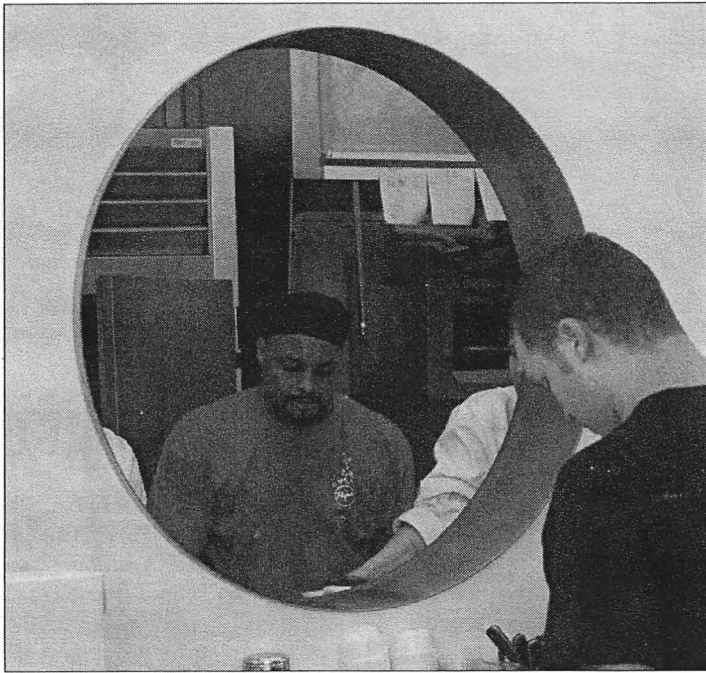

The Oklahoma Route 66 Association invites all interested roadies to participate in a special fall museum cruise from Arcadia to El Reno.

The cruise, slated for Saturday, Oct. 13, will begin at 9 a.m. at POPS, 660 W. Highway 66 in Arcadia. POPS is a new Route 66 attraction that opened in August and features a retro-styled diner, a collection of 12,000 pop bottles, and a 66-foot-high pop bottle lit with LEDs.

Four hundred different kinds of soda are available for purchase at POPS, located on Route 66 west of the Round Barn.

From POPS, cruisers will head to the Oklahoma History Center, 2401 N. Laird in Oklahoma City. Admission to the center is \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors age 62 and up, and \$4 for groups of 10 or more. Children get in free.

Cruisers will have the chance

to stop for lunch at Rt. 66 Bar-B-Que, located at 400 E. Main, Suite A, in Yukon.

After lunch, cruisers will proceed to the Canadian County Historical Museum, 300 S. Grand at the Rock Island Depot in El Reno. Admission to the museum is free, but donations are accepted. Those who wish to ride El Reno's trolley may do so; rides cost \$3 for adults and \$1.50 for children, seniors 65 and up, and individuals with disabilities.

After the tour, participants will head to Historic Fort Reno, 7107 W. Cheyenne St. in El Reno, for a tour. Admission to Historic Fort Reno is free.

The tour will conclude with dinner or coffee and pie at an as-yet-to-be-determined location.

SHPO honors those involved in ghost sign restoration

A large, century-old and very faded ghost sign is now back in full view for eastbound Route 66 travelers in Chandler.

The dim, hardly legible lettering high on a second-story wall at 14th Street and Manvel Avenue (Route 66) proclaims: "St. Cloud Hotel — Delicious and Refreshing Coca-Cola Relieves Fatigue."

Conservation of lettering with techniques and colors that do not make the sign look weathered and original — not bright and new — won the State Historic Preservation Officer's Citation of Merit Award this spring for mural artists Dean Codner and Shaun Colbert and Great Plains Coca Cola Bottling Company, which financed the project.

An award also went to building owner John Givens.

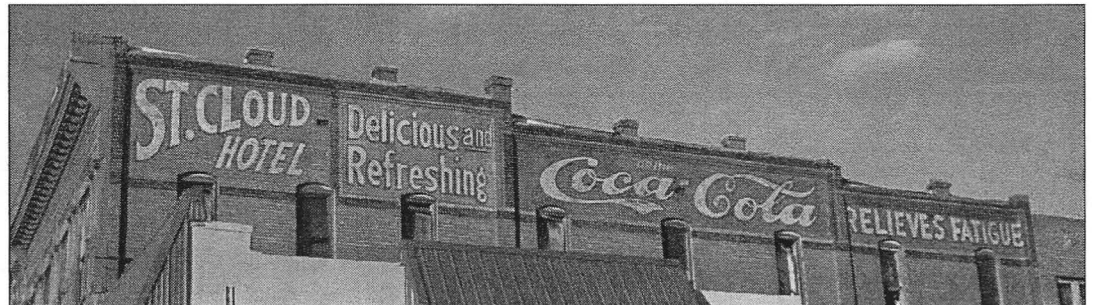

Dr. Bob Blackburn, State Historic Preservation Officer, and Deputy Director Melvena Heisch presented the awards at the May 2007 State Preservation Conference in Guthrie.

The 100-foot-long sign advertises the St. Cloud Hotel, housed for many years in the 1903 building.

It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places for its importance to Route 66

travel-related historic places and Territorial Commercial Buildings of Chandler.

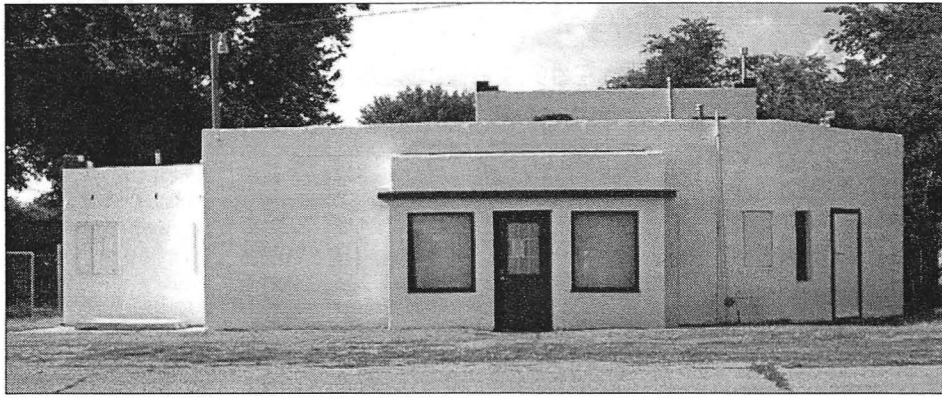
The hotel was known as a special place for traveling salesmen. It was near the train station and offered a special room for displaying their wares and a separate, private dining room.

Givens operates a muffler shop in the building, which has often been vacant and several times has been condemned by

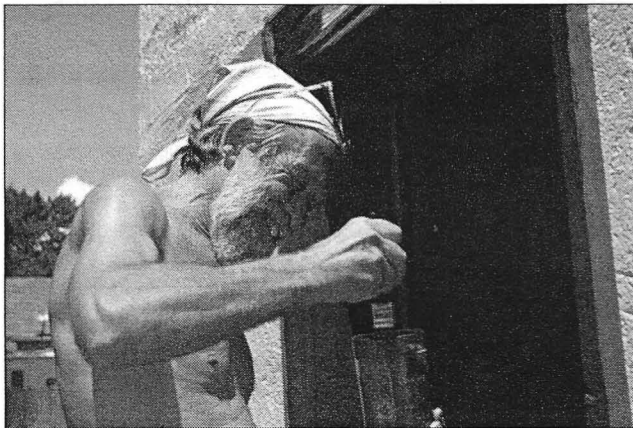
the city. The building features a pressed-metal second-story facade and once had a front balcony. The Silver King Bar was once a first-level feature.

Westbound Route 66 cruisers can pull over just before 14th Street and look to their left for a rare view of a giant, authentic, early-day promotion for Coke or pop before driving on towards the new tribute to soda pop, Arcadia's POPS.

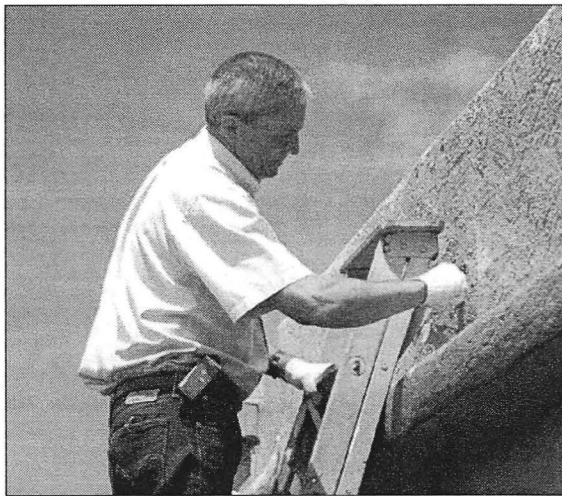
Below: Michael Wallis, better known as the Sheriff of Radiator Springs, helps paint the trim at Ray's Motel.



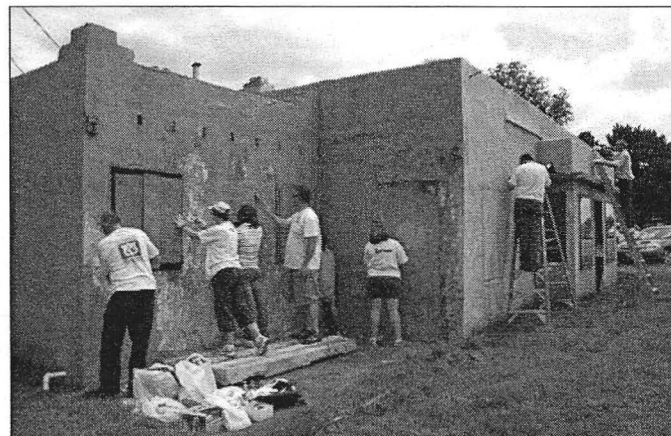
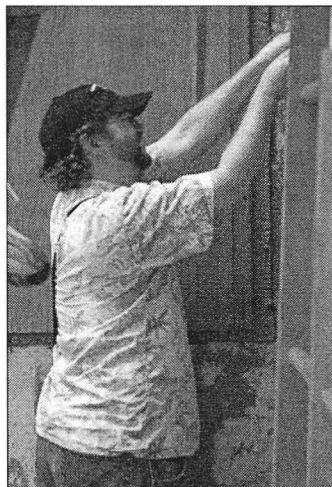
Making history by saving history

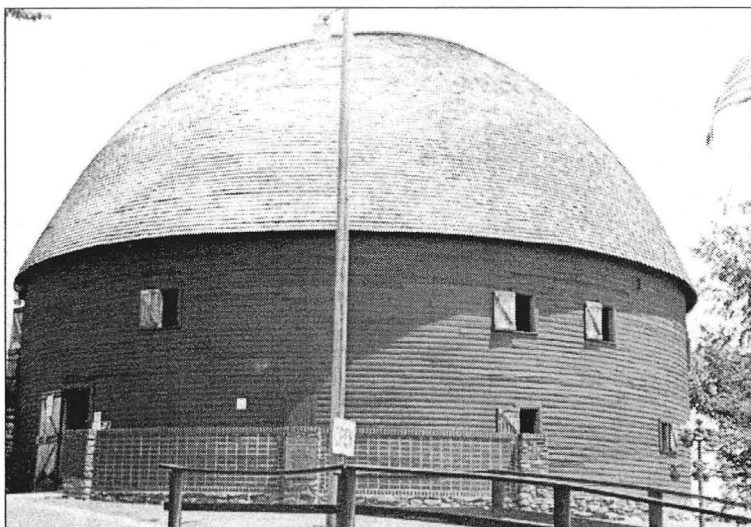
