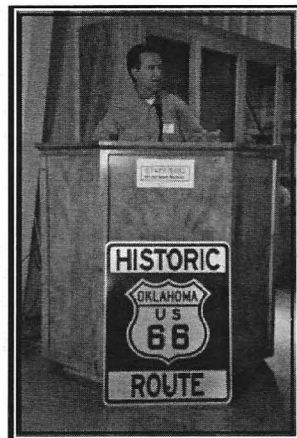

The conference room was packed as Marion Davidson extended a warm Mother Road welcome, and reminisced of hometown changes through the years on Route 66 as a result of I-40.



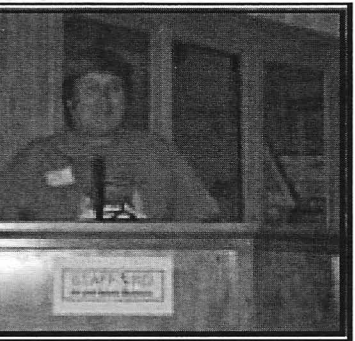

Weatherford Mayor Mike D Brown stressed the overall importance of Route 66 to Weatherford, and of the progressive development of the Stafford Museum.

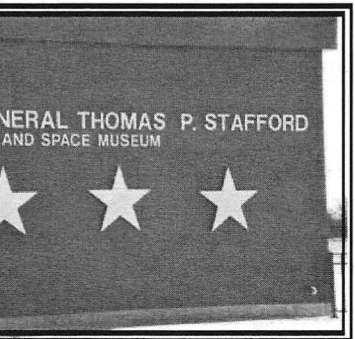

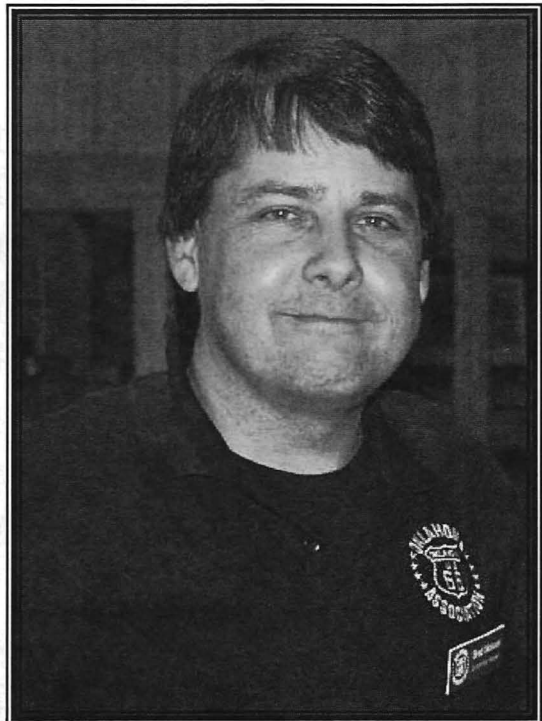
Oklahoma Route 66 ... Meet your Board members ... Spotlight

Brad Nickson, Tulsa County Rep

Brad is a newcomer to Oklahoma. He and wife LaSandra arrived in July 1997. His interest in Route 66 pre-dated their arrival to Tulsa, however. Brad has worked in higher education as a software developer for over two decades, and Route 66 is a nice break from the high-tech world that takes up most of his time.

Brad joined the Oklahoma Route 66 Association in 2001 shortly before one of the annual state-wide cruises. Soon afterward, he became the Tulsa County Representative. Most recently, he also accepted the position of Eastern Vice President.

Brad served on the Board of Directors for the 2004 International Route 66 Festival in Tulsa. He continues to serve on the design recommendation committee for Tulsa County's Route 66 Vision 2025 project to determine where and how the \$15,000,000 will be spent. One of the many projects included in that package was the signage directing travelers along the two alignments of Route 66 in the county. Other projects include restoration of the Meadow Gold sign and the construction of the pedestrian bridge by the Cyrus Avery Route 66 Memorial Bridge. Several other projects are still in progress.

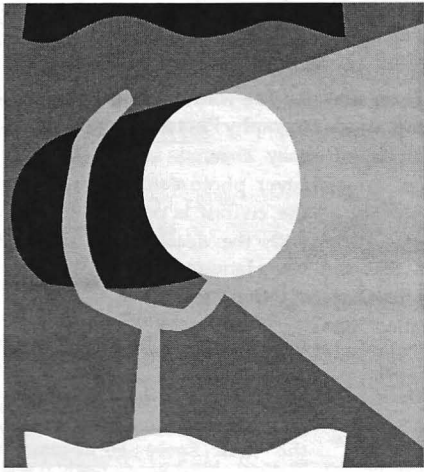

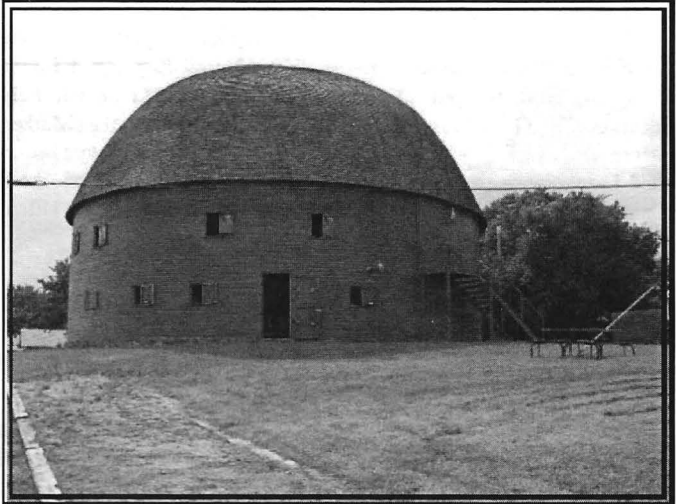
Arcadia Historical & Preservation Society

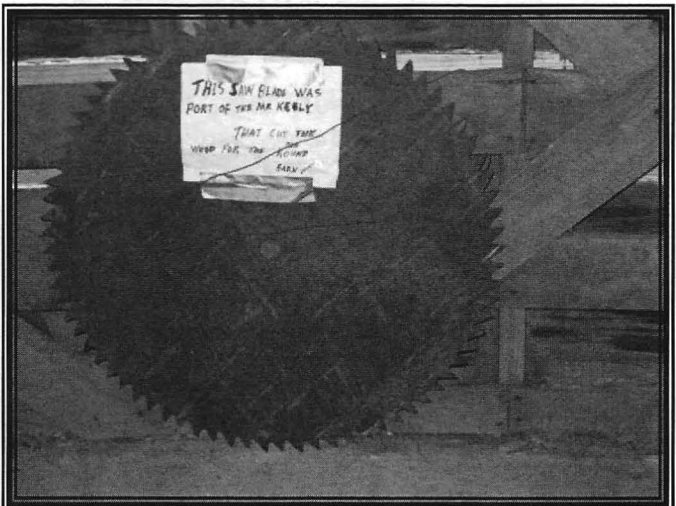

Minutes from the Oklahoma Route 66 Association quarterly meeting

The Oklahoma Route 66 Association held its summer quarterly meeting at 1pm, October 18, 2009 at the Stafford Air and Space Museum, 3000 Logan Road, Weatherford, Oklahoma.

President Mike Hickey called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance. Minutes from the July quarterly meeting were approved via email or land line prior to the Quarterly Meeting.

President Mike Hickey announced that the following positions will be open for re-elections at the January 2010 Annual Meeting in Chandler: Secretary, Treasurer, Creek County Rep, Custer County Rep, Ottawa County Rep, Rogers County Rep, Washita County Rep, and vacant positions of Delaware/Craig and Blaine/Caddo County Reps.

Eastern VP Brad Nickson described the good turnout at the dedication of Red Fork Crossing.

Western VP Jerald Ashby welcomed Larry Nance to the position of Canadian County Rep.

Treasurer Kim Evans shared a hardcopy income/expense report, broken into three different time periods: 1-12-09 thru 4-19-09, 4-20-09 thru 7-19-09, and 7-19-09 thru 10-18-09

The total income reported was \$5,860 ... down significantly from past quarterly incomes.

Administrator Marilyn Emde reported 15 new memberships and 88 renewals in the last quarter. The letters included in the mailed Trip Guides concerning donations to cover shipping had no response.

*** Old Business**

- Jerald Ashby had no information on the upcoming Holiday Light Cruise at this time. He will report via email or land line as soon as plans are confirmed.

- Carol Duncan reported that she spoke to Laurel Kane, and David Kane confirmed that he will help transport and place the Marker. The total cost for the marker is \$2,860. To date, \$1,540 has been raised in donations and \$1110 in

fundraisers. Carol was instructed by the Board to send the funds raised so far to the Association Administrator for distribution, in accordance with the laws of liability.

***New Business**

- Marilyn Emde reported that she didn't have a final cost of the Oklahoma Route 66 Association 20th Anniversary Celebration, but will have it in a few days, and will report via email or landline.

- The Oklahoma Route 66 Association Annual Meeting will be on January 10, 2010, at 12:00 noon in the Chandler Public Library meeting room, located at 1021 Manvel Avenue, Chandler. A potluck will precede the meeting. The 2010 quarterly meetings will be held on April 18, July 18, and October 17, 2010, at 2:00pm at the Oklahoma Tourism Information Center at 122nd and I-35 in OKC.

- Marilyn Emde reported that January 15 is the first deadline for ads to be turned in for the Trip Guide. The absolute final deadline is March

5. The winner of the Blunck's Photography Photo Contest is automatically entered in the Trip Guide cover photo contest. In addition, the contest is open to the public, with the deadline for submission being January 18, 2010.

*** Other Business**

- Marilyn Emde informed the Board that Carolyn and Mike Pendleton of the Kansas Association (Baxter Springs) mentioned the possible cooperation of the tri-state area Associations in affiliation with the 2010 Route 66 International Festival. Next year's festival will be held in Joplin, Missouri on June 10-12. Jerald Ashby mentioned a cruise encompassing the three states.

- Ron Burden asked is the Association was going to sponsor a 2009 Fall Cruise. NO was the response.

- Brad proposed that the holiday letter be sent out this year to members. Kim Evans made a motion to accept the proposal. Jill Ann Church seconded. Motion passed.

Kim Evans motioned the meeting to adjourn, Brad Nickson seconded, motion passed. Meeting adjourned.

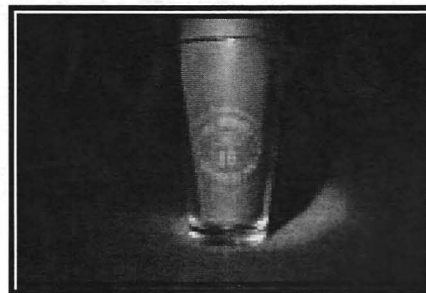

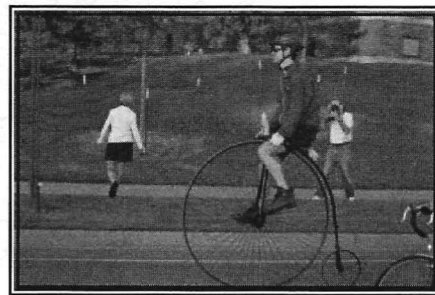
The Bike Rally, held September 26-27, was a great success, as reported by MS development manager Blaine King.
