

Marion Davidson was born in Elk City (Beckham County) Oklahoma. His family purchased and moved to a farm near Roll Community in Rogers County in 1933.



Thank you, Marion, for all the wonderful work you do for both Oklahoma Route 66, and the OK Route 66 Association.







### The National Route 66 Museum




The Museum also houses an extensive collection of travel and museum brochures for the area around Elk City and greater Oklahoma and the staff is always more than happy to share this information with travelers.
