## Oklahoma Route 66 Clean-up Kick-off in Sapulpa

**SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA** - The Bird Creek Bridge was recently a gathering spot for participants in the first annual Oklahoma Route 66 Association's Keep Oklahoma Beautiful project. Several members and friends of the Association gathered in Sapulpa on a wet and unusually chilly Saturday, April 17, to get down to the business of cleaning up litter and debris along the Mother Road. Dressed in jackets for warmth, orange safety vests,

The project began mid-morning. Following a much appreciated lunch provided by Boomerangs of Sapulpa, the crew finished up gathering trash and filled the trucks to haul it all away by mid afternoon.

The team collected approximately 700 lb of trash and 35 lb of recyclables. The recyclables were donated to the Sapulpa Handicapped Opportunity Workshop (SHOW).

Some of the interesting items found during the clean-up included a cell phone, flatware items, a few tools, and an inflatable mattress.

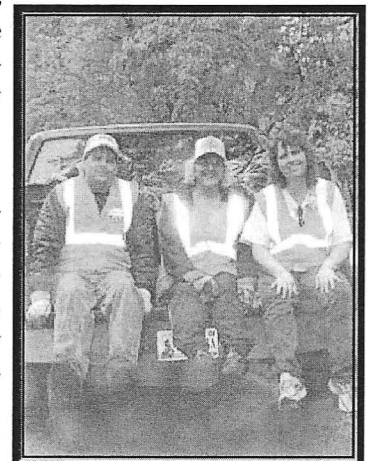

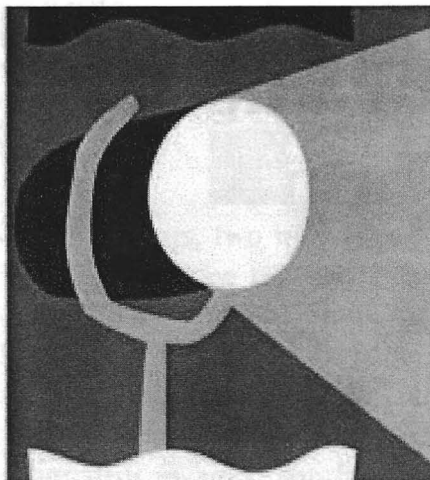

## Marion Davidson, far-Western District Rep

Marion Davidson was born in Elk City (Beckham County) Oklahoma. His family purchased and moved to a farm near Roll Community in Rogers County in 1933.

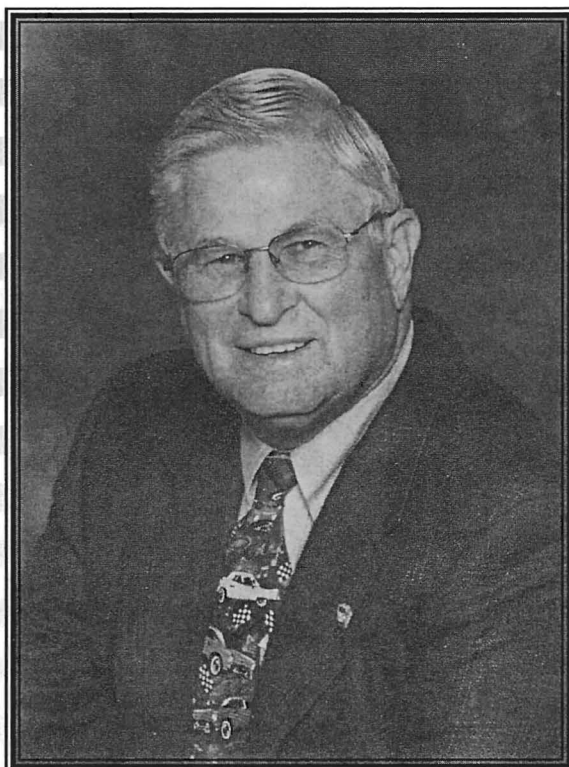
Marion graduated from Crawford High School in 1945, and later that same year, he moved with his family to Carter, Oklahoma, helping out on the farm throughout the week. On weekends, Marion worked at Carter Grocery Store and Meat Market. This experience eventually led to training for an occupation as a butcher, working in area markets for the next 5 years.

In January, 1951, Marion was drafted into the Army and served in Korea as Sgt in Engr Co for two years, followed by 6 years in the 95th Reserve and National Guard Service. He then attended night classes at Sayre Jr College on the GI Bill, all the while working in sales at Cheyenne Chevrolet.

Marion met his life-long partner, Dolores Dooty, while in Cheyenne, and they married in 1955. The following year, they moved to Weatherford, where he continued what has become a life-long passion in auto dealership on Route 66. They are active members of the Weatherford United Methodist Church, and serve on the Finance Committee.

In 2001, Marion organized the Route 66 Thunderbirds, buying and selling antique and special interest vehicles as a part-time business. He continues to volunteer his time and efforts at the two Route 66 museums which preserve the heritage of western Oklahoma, as well as in festivals and car shows.

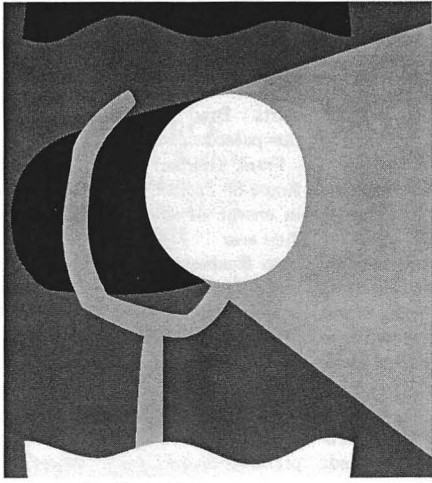

## The National Route 66 Museum

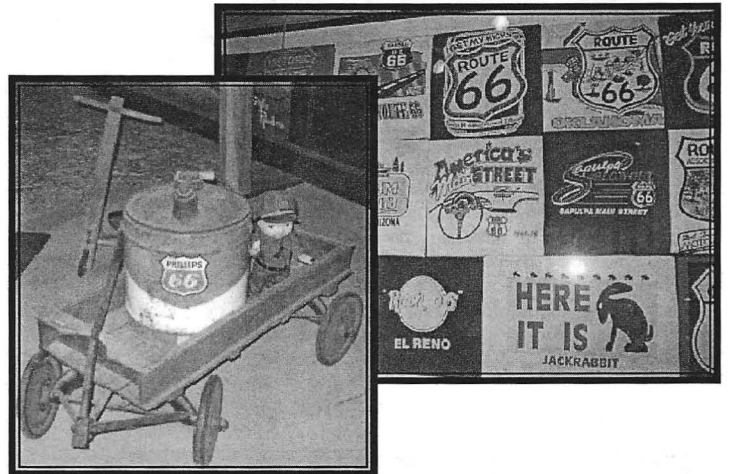


The National Route 66 Museum uses a road motif to allow visitors to travel through all eight states along Route 66 "The Mother Road". The trip begins in Chicago and ends in California. Murals and different vignettes depict the eras of the road and the interesting places that made Route 66 so famous. As you travel along, you can listen to recorded histories and personal accounts of the road from overhead audio kiosks.

The Museum also houses an extensive collection of travel and museum brochures for the area around Elk City and greater Oklahoma and the staff is always more than happy to share this information with travelers.

The National Route 66 Museum curator is Wanda Queenan who along with her husband Reece owned and operated the famous Queenan Trading Post on Route 66 on the west edge of Elk City. Wanda and the two Kachina dolls that stood guard outside the Trading Post have moved to the National Route 66 Museum and she has lots of interesting stories to share!

# Minutes from the Oklahoma Route 66 Association spring meeting

The 2010 Spring Meeting of the Oklahoma Route 66 Association was called to order by President Mike Hickey. 17 members and guests were present.

- President Mike Hickey called the meeting to order. Jill Ann Church made the motion to approve the minutes from the January Annual meeting, BaLinda Miller seconded, motion passed.

Mike Hickey extended a thank you to everyone who turned out to help in the Keep Oklahoma Beautiful workday in Sapulpa on Saturday, April 17.

- Eastern Vice President Brad Nickson presented the numbers concerning the Keep Oklahoma Beautiful, Rock Creek Bridge clean-up. There were 15 workers present to assist in the project, 40 trash sacks of trash and recyclables collected. Brad also reported that the Twin Bridges meeting was to be held Tuesday, April 20 at the Indian Activity Center in Catoosa.

- Western Vice President Jerald Ashby shared that a Route 66 Bridge east of Weatherford was removed and will be replaced, along with some road repair. The construction of a plant has increased heavy truck and equipment activity on Route 66, but there is no evidence of road damage as a result. Western tourism is increasing as a result of increased advertizing.

- Treasurer Kim Evans was not present at the meeting, and Marilyn Emde gave an unofficial treasurer's report of a checking balance of \$15,325.21.

- Marilyn Emde gave the administrator's report. The Association acquired

17 new members and 74 renewals since the Annual meeting. Marilyn spoke with the Association's webmaster, and between March 15 - April 14 there were 4984 hits on our website, averaging 160.77 hits per day.

- Alliance Chairman Rick Freeland shared information about the newly formed Route 66 Alliance, and its potential to assist in the financial stability of Route 66 Associations and businesses far into the future.

- Association member Karen Nance offered an opportunity to generate funds for the Association through a fundraising venture with "Celebrating Homes," selling candles and specialty foods. The Association would earn half of the total sales. Karen said the Association needed to provide a tax exempt letter. A date was not determined to begin the fund raiser, but will be addressed in the near future. President Mike Hickey recommended that the fundraiser last for three weeks.

## Old Business

\* The Sapulpa Blowout will be held on June 5. Frank Gierhart reported that the festival is planned and ready to go, and that the Oklahoma Route 66 Association booth will be set up out front of the Route 66 Frame Shoppe.

\* The National Main Street Conference will be held the first week in May at the Cox Convention Center in OKC. Its purpose is to offer a one-day workshop about making a town a main street community. Booths for the event are \$1600, and the Association will not have a booth at this event.

\* The Stroud Wine Festival is June 12. Jeanne Miller will have a booth, and requested assistance for the event.

\* The Oklahoma Route 66 Cruise/Poker Run, tentatively scheduled for June 19, has been cancelled.

\* The Route 66 Tri-State International Festival will be held June 17-20 in Quapaw, OK. In an 11-1 vote, it was decided not to send a representative to the Festival for financial reasons. There was discussion of a 4-State/3-Day tour, from Friday-Sunday, to be held in 2011, in conjunction with the Litchfield, IL Festival. Jill Ann Church made a motion to go forward with the plans for this event with the Kansas, Missouri and Illinois Associations, BaLinda Miller seconded. Motion passed.

\* The Oklahoma Route 66 Association will not participate in Clinton's Hot Dogs and Hot Rods Festival this year.

- Mike Hickey spoke with Harley Earls concerning the placement of the Afton Marker, and learned of County easement issues. The Marker will be placed as soon as issues are resolved, and Mike wishes to have an official dedication. The protocol for future markers was discussed.

- There was a discussion about the 2011 budget. The Oklahoma Department of Tourism as increased their Trip Guide to \$16,000 and requested additional Trip Guides. Trip Guide sales equaled \$25,395.50. Marilyn Emde asked if the Association wanted to order more t-shirts. There was a decision to order 90 shirts at a total cost of \$537.50. Jill Ann Church made a motion to order the

shirts. Brad Nickson seconded. Motion passed.

- Frank Gierhart will chair the Adopt Route 66 Project. Each District will be in charge of scheduling the event for their area

**New Business:** Hall of Fame Awards will be held September 19 at 2pm, in conjunction with the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum's 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The Harley Davidson Cruisers are scheduled to be passing through the area around this time also, providing an additional 600 in attendance for the presentation.

- The Oklahoma Route 66 Board of Trustees Retreat was proposed. The retreat would be a weekend trip planned to discuss marketing plans, budgets, and fund raisers for the future. No decisions were made, but it was suggested that the retreat be on Saturday and Sunday in Chandler.

**Other Business:** The 2010 membership drive will be discussed at the July meeting.

**Announcements:** The Oklahoma Route 66 Association will be awarded the 2010 State Historic Preservation Officer's Citation of Merit at the awards presentation and banquet in Okmulgee on June 10.

ODOT has not made an announcement of Oklahoma Route 66's induction to the National Scenic Byways.

Frank Gierhart made a motion to adjourn. BaLinda Miller seconded. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.

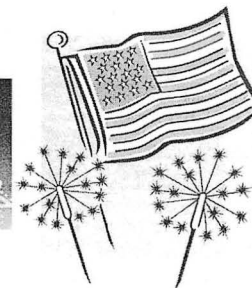
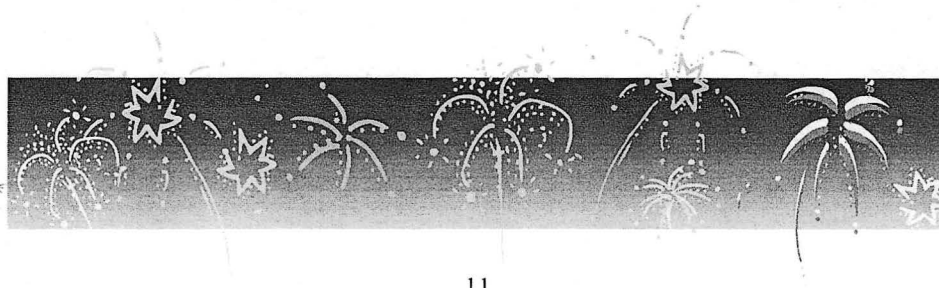
