



# Frank Gierhart, Creek District Rep



With Frank's diverse work background, he has been a stellar force in advancing the growth and development of Oklahoma Route 66.





Waylan's Ku-Ku is an original fast food drive-in from the 1960's. Back then, there were close to 200 Ku-Ku's, but the Miami restaurant is the only one still standing.
