- Pat Henderson presented an update on the Postage Stamp Project that she is proceeding.

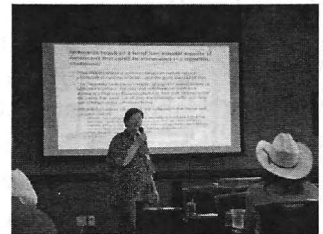

history of American roads through her presentation of Legends of America.

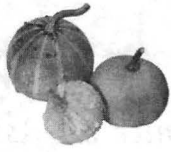

- Babs Tims shared of how she is educating her 4th grade class about the Mother Road through all elements of education.

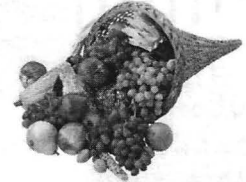
- Sue Stringer of Kansas DOT and Kelli Hillard of the Kansas Commerce Tourism Department presented the advancements of Route 66 in Kansas.

Route 66 Museum to Celebrate 15th Anniversary

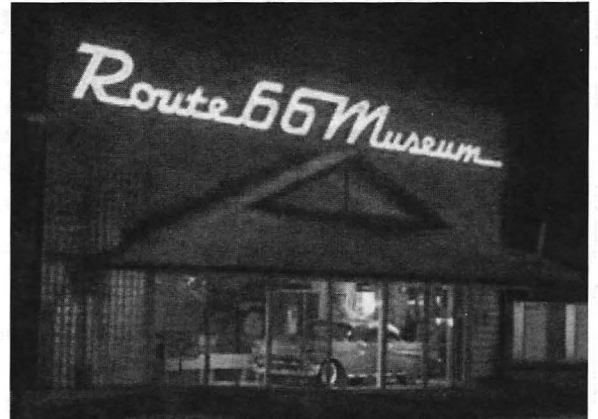
CLINTON, OKLAHOMA - On September 19, 2010, the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum in Clinton, OK will be celebrating 15 years of promotion and preservation of Route 66. Along with the anniversary festivities, the Museum will also be hosting the 2010 Oklahoma Route 66 Association's Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony and welcoming the hundreds of H.O.G.s (Harley Owners Group) on their 2010 Rally, *Motoring the Mother Road*. The festivities will begin at 2:00pm (entertainment and refreshments will begin at 1:00pm) in the museum's famed Wow! Room, which is free to the public.

With over 550,000 visitors in 15 years, the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum has captivated the attention of people from around the world. The museum which originally opened on September 23, 1995, promotes the history of Route 66 by telling its story from beginning to end. To open the day's events, Museum Director, Pat Smith, will speak about the success of the museum. As an added bonus, mu-

seum volunteers will also share their favorite Route 66 memories or stories.

Next, the Oklahoma Route 66 Association will induct two "special Oklahomans" into the Oklahoma Route 66 Hall of Fame. Inductions are held every two years for individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the promotion and/or preservation of Route 66. The selection includes a nomination and committee process conducted by the association. The winners' plaques are displayed in the museum on the Hall of Fame (located in the Wow! Room).

Also joining the festivities will be approximately 600 HOGs, or Harley Davidson riders, traveling Route 66 in the 2010 Rally, *Motoring the Mother Road*. The rally is a two-week excursion beginning in Chicago, IL on September 11, 2010 and ending in Los Angeles, CA on September 25, 2010. The HOGs will be stopping at the museum throughout the day as they



make their way to Amarillo, TX. The Oklahoma Route 66 Museum will be open from 9:00 am to 5:00pm. Attendees are invited to share the museum's birthday cake while listening to the rock 'n roll hits heard in most cars as they traveled Route 66. The event is sponsored by the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, and the Friends of the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum, INC. The museum is located at 2229 W. 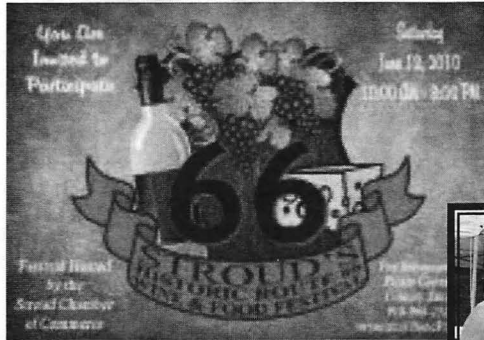

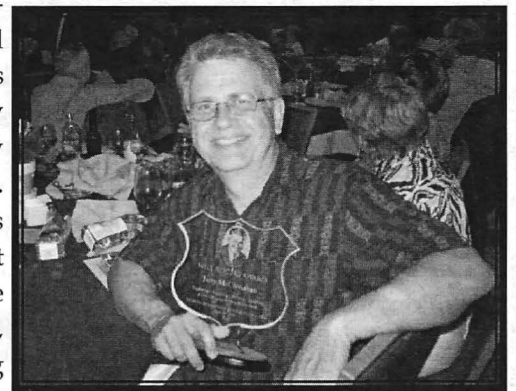

Oklahoma's own Jerry McClanahan wins award at festival

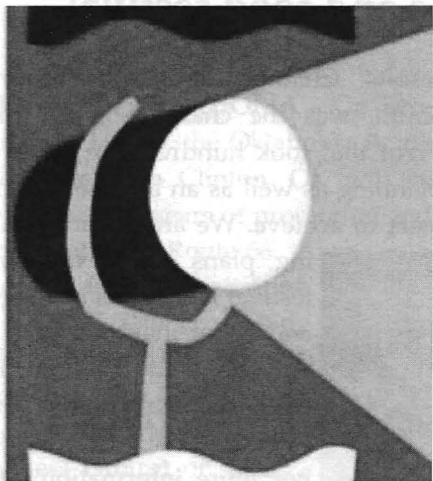

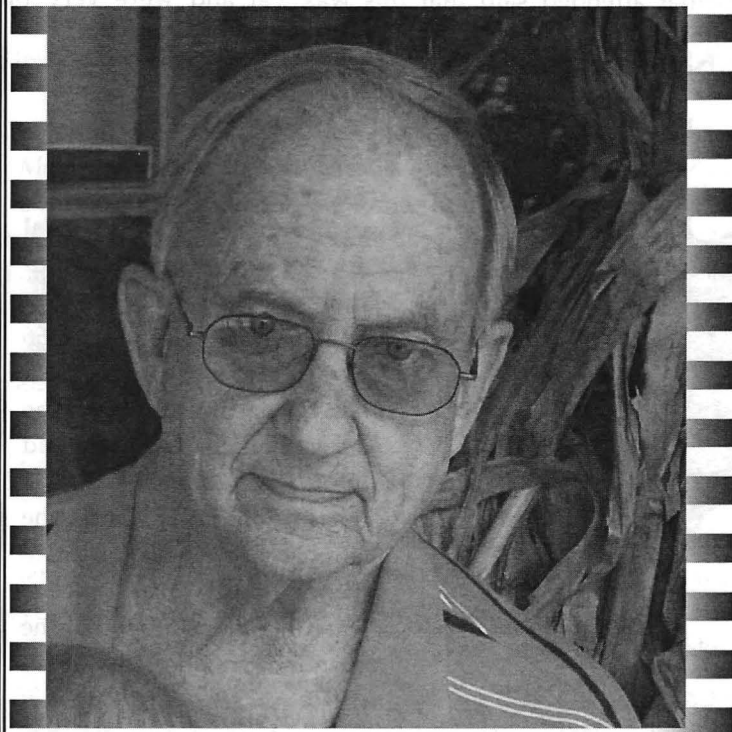
Frank Gierhart, Creek District Rep

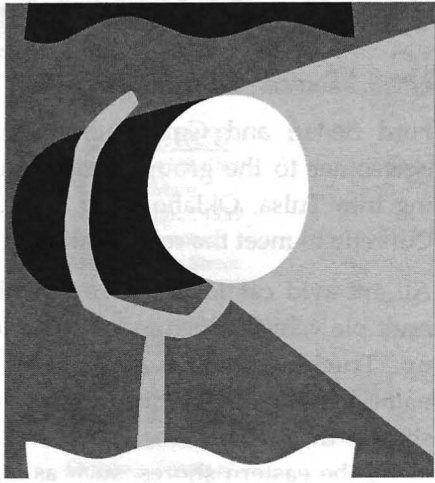
With Frank's diverse work background, he has been a stellar force in advancing the growth and development of Oklahoma Route 66.

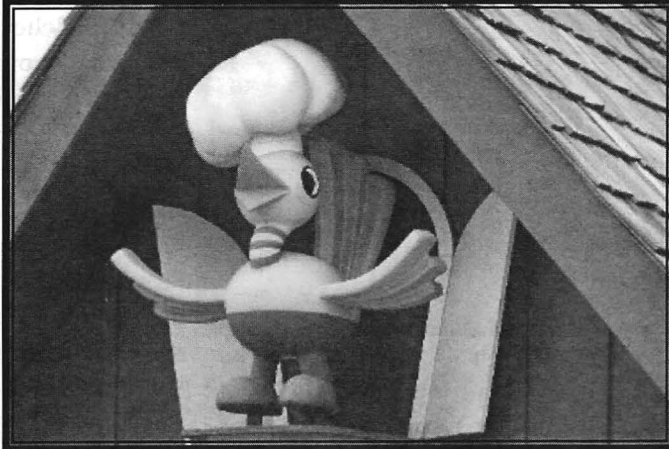

Waylan's Ku-Ku Burger



Waylan's Ku-Ku Burger, a Route 66 landmark in Miami, Oklahoma, is recognized by its giant yellow cuckoo bird popping out of the storefront, but is known and remembered by its one-of-a-kind burgers and fries. Gene Waylan has owned the Miami Ku-Ku since 1973, and has been the master cook for almost as long. "I do most of the cooking myself," admits the proud and experienced entrepreneur. He also admits that he has a frequent turn-over of employees, because they just don't meet his expectations.

Waylan's Ku-Ku is an original fast food drive-in from the 1960's. Back then, there were close to 200 Ku-Ku's, but the Miami restaurant is the only one still standing. As one of the most nostalgic stops on Route 66, Waylan's offers burgers, fries and frozen desserts, and everything is cooked to order.
