The Oklahoma Route 66 Association celebrated 25 years of "Getting Their Kicks" and handed out their Hall of

Fame Awards on Saturday, 2:00 P.M. October 18 at the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum in Clinton.

The Oklahoma Route 66 Association is a not-for-profit organization made up of volunteers who are dedicated to the promotion and preservation of Route 66. The purpose of the Association is to promote, enhance, perpetuate, encourage the develop-

ment of tourism, economic opportunities, and historic resources and landmarks along Oklahoma's section of Route 66. They are celebrating 25 years of promoting Oklahoma's section of Route 66, which is a National Scenic Byway, on October 16.

## 2014 Hall of Fame Winners

### Marian Wilson Clark

Marian Clark is the author of THE ROUTE 66 COOK-BOOK, THE MAIN STREET OF AMERICA COOKBOOK, the SOUTHWESTERN HERITAGE COOKBOOK and is coauthor with Michael Wallis of HOGS ON 66, released in December of 2004. Over 30,000 copies of her books have sold to date.

A passion for food and a love affair with Route 66 led Clark on her first journey of discovery along the historic highway between Chicago and Santa Monica in the fall of 1990. On the way she rediscovered many of the famous and not-so-famous eateries along America's Main Street. She has interviewed hard working entrepreneurs, chefs, waitresses and fellow travelers from around the world. Her many trips have resulted in a masterful collection of stories and recipes hidden behind the neon signs and gravel parking lots in over 150 American communities.

Marian has written for several magazines and travel publications, has appeared on the Food Channel, on the Michael Feldman show and on British TV in the series, "Cookabout with Greg and Max: Route66. She shares her enthusiasm for Route 66 as a speaker and has coordinated several tours and classes along Route 66. She was a director of the Tulsa International Route 66 Festival In Tulsa in 2004.

In June of 2007 she was selected as the "Route 66 Personality of the Year" at the Route 66 International Route 66 Festival. She is native of Hereford, Texas. Marian holds a degree in vocational home economics from Texas Tech and has done graduate work in foods and nutrition. She is a volunteer at the Tulsa Historical Society, Friends of the Tulsa city/County Library and a member of the Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary.

### John Monroe Davis (1887-1973)

Davis was seven years old when his father gave him his first rifle; a muzzle loading shotgun that cost \$ 1.50. That was the beginning of a lifetime of collecting firearms and other unique artifacts from all over the world. Davis traveled to Claremore in 1916 in search of investment opportunities and stayed at the Mason Hotel, which was for sale. He purchased the hotel and soon began displaying his growing collection of firearms in the hotel.

The hotel's location was in the center of town. It was across the street from the passenger train station, the city bus station was next door and the newly built highway sixty-six ran in front of the hotel. People from all over the world came to the hotel and saw Davis' growing arms collection.

In 1965, Davis transferred ownership of the collection to the J.M. Davis Foundation and leased the collection to the state of Oklahoma. In exchange, the state of Oklahoma built the J.M. Davis Arms and Historical Museum and continues to maintain and care for the world's largest privately held arms collection. There are 14,000 arms in the collection and over 50,000 total artifacts in the museum.

The museum sits two blocks north of the original hotel location on the original Route 66 built in Claremore in 1926. It draws visitors the world over. The J,M. Davis Arms and Historical Museum remains a centerpiece of the "Mother Road", Route 66.

The Chamber also has partnered with the Sac & Fox Nation. Together they will be sponsoring 4 to 6 events a year on the Rodeo Grounds.



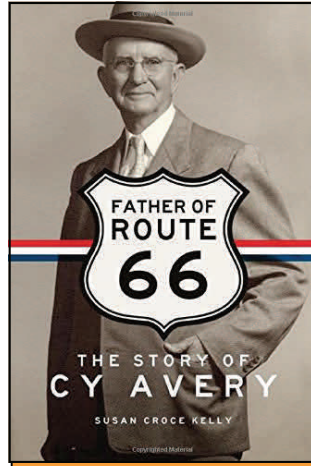
The Stroud Chamber has also partnered with the Route 66 Community Partners. The Route 66 Community Partners has received a SET

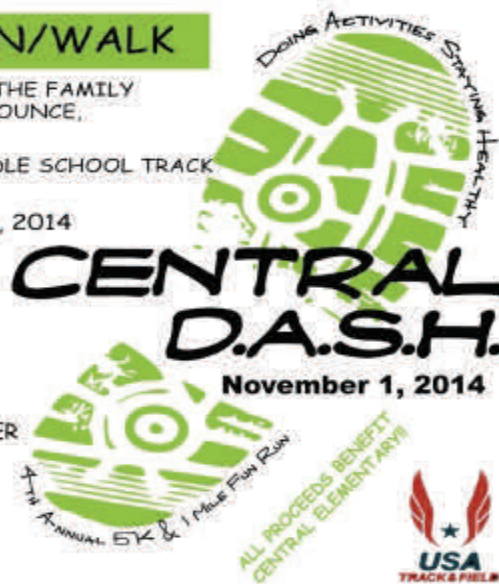

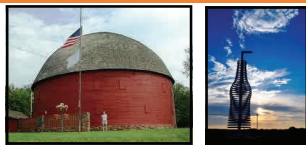

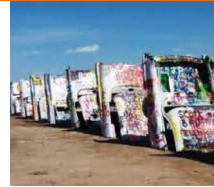
