Casa Grande: The Grand House

It was 1926 and World War I was over. The highway system for the state of Oklahoma was taking on a new look. Tourism enticed people to get out of their houses and on the road.

The Chamber of Commerce of Elk City had implemented a new action plan to ensure the prosperity of their city. One of the goals was the construction of a beautiful hotel. A hotel that would draw travelers and conventions, from across the United States and around the world.

Fate stepped in, when in 1927, Edward M. Woody had a flat tire and pulled into M & M Oil Company Station for repairs. Mr. Woody, an experienced motel manager, noted that the location across the street from the M&M was well suited for a hotel.

With the approval of the Elk City Chamber, the wheels were set in motion. Hawk & Parr Architect out of Oklahoma City and Walter



Architects Hawk and Parr designed the four-story building in the Spanish Eclectic style; their design features arched windows and doors and stone ornamentation along the arches.

S. Krompsi Contractor from Bristow, were commissioned to erect the largest hotel between Oklahoma City and Amarillo. The hotel was named Casa Grande and was located at the corner of third and Route 66. The grand opening was in 1928.

Casa Grande Con't....

The Casa Grande enjoyed being the plum of Elk City through the 1930's. In 1931, Elk City was the host of the National Route 66 Convention. Dignitaries in attendance included Governor William Murray and representatives from the other Route 66 states. The festivities started with a parade and ended with a banquet and dance which was held at the Casa Grande.

Between 1950 and 1968 the hotel was sold several times and eventually fell on hard times and closed.

New life came to the Casa Grande in 1985. It was deeded to the Western Oklahoma Earth and Science Museum, now known as the Anadarko Basin Museum of Natural History. The museum's 1st exhibit was the collection of Lynn C. Billau of Tulsa, an Elk City native. The collection included rocks, fossil and minerals. Today the ABMNH has an outstanding collection of minerals, fossils, natural history rocks, petrified wood, Native American pictures, paintings and beadwork, oil & gas memorabilia, art & photographs, oil & gas exploration and production equipment.



In 1990, local businessman, John West spearheaded a project to draw yet more attention to this grand old hotel. Due to his efforts, one of the Parker Drilling Rigs is now located on the back lot of the hotel. It can be seen for miles.

In 1995 the Casa Grande was granted its place on the National Register of Historic Places.

Along with the Museum, the Casa Grande has been converted into apartments. As long as the people of Elk City continue to explore all avenues, gems like the Casa Grande will be enjoyed by generations to come.

Vinita Area Chamber of Commerce

It was at the crossing of the first railroads to enter what is now eastern Oklahoma that Vinita, I.T., was born in 1871. The city thrived and in 1907 the Vinita Chamber of Commerce was chartered.

After 98 years, the Chamber located at 105 Delaware Ave. has continued to promote the purpose and mission of the area chamber....

"To support, promote and enhance in our area, the economic climate, human care services, educational system, awareness and involvement in politics and government, tourism, emphasis on local trade and community pride."

The current Executive Board is comprised of President-Janet Link, Past President-Kristi Allensworth, Treasurer-Lisa Lambert and Executive Assistant-Cindy McCabe.

Things were buzzing when I met with Janet and Cindy at the Chamber office. They were hard at work preparing for the 1st Annual Historic Route 66 Festival in downtown Vinita.

The Festival will be held in conjunction with the Worlds Largest Calf Fry at the American Legion Rodeo Grounds and the Big Truck & Tractor Show at the Bull Creek Shopping Center.

The World's Largest Calf Fry Festival was started in

1979 when three businessmen in Vinita were given the task of finding an activity that would represent the area and be fun for the public. Jim Shelton contacted a friend in west Texas about a "Rocky Mountain Oyster Fry" held each year and liked the idea. Fellow organizers Larry Green and John Myers agreed and a few months later the World's Largest Calf Fry Festival and Cook-off became a reality in Vinita.

The Calf Fry Festival has grown each year, from an initial attendance of 600 in Year One to over 12,000.

For those afraid to venture into the gourmet world of calf-fry tasting, other mouth-watering food items such as cobblers, salsa, cowboy breads, beans and much more are available. Mark your calendars: June 13th, 2015 for the 36th Annual World's Largest Calf Fry Festival in Vinita, OK.

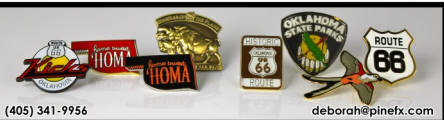

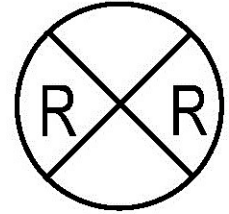
