## The Road Ahead Looks Promising

Envision a new national framework for collaboration along Route 66 that creates – for the first time ever – a single place where tourism officials, economic development professionals, members of state and national Route 66 associations, business persons, preservationists, educators, not-for-profits, and government officials work together to revitalize and renew Historic Route 66.

Concrete steps to achieve this vision began this past July when over 300 people took part in a series of Route 66 Collaboration Workshops. The workshops commenced July 21st in Springfield, Illinois, and included meetings in Springfield, Missouri; Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; Amarillo, Texas; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Flagstaff, Arizona; and San Bernardino, California.

The purpose of the Collaboration Workshops was to gather feedback regarding a proposed new national framework for collaboration amongst Route 66 stakeholders. Workshop attendees included preservationists, government officials, members of Route 66 associations, educators,

tourism officials, economic development professionals, businesspersons, and others interested in working together to preserve and promote the Mother Road.

By way of background, the Collaboration Workshops were designed and put on by a group called “Route 66: The Road Ahead Initiative”. The Initiative began when organizational leaders and representative stakeholders of Route 66 met in November 2013 at the Route 66: The Road Ahead Strategic Roundtable in Anaheim, California. Organized by the World Monuments Fund (WMF), the primary purpose of the Roundtable meeting was to discuss the results of a Route 66 Economic Impact Study (2012) conducted for the WMF by Rutgers University. One of the key recommendations from the Roundtable meeting called for development of a new national framework for collaboration amongst Route 66 stakeholders. Consensus was reached at the

Roundtable, that the WMF and the National Park Service (NPS) would facilitate a process to bring stakeholders together to develop the proposed new framework for national collaboration amongst Rt. 66 stakeholders.

To jump-start this process, WMF and NPS appointed an ad-hoc Steering Committee comprised of representatives from tourism, preservation, transportation, small business, economic development, education, and state and national Route 66 organizations. In November 2014, the Steering Committee met for two days in Albuquerque, New Mexico to finalize recommendations developed over a period of months.

There, the Steering Committee reached consensus on a proposed new organization designed to facilitate national collaboration amongst Rt. 66 stakeholders. The proposed structure of the new organization includes proposals for a representative elected board, along with working groups/committees designed to promote tourism, preservation, Route 66 Associations (advocacy), economic development, and education.

The ultimate goal is to fashion a fresh, inclusive approach for Route 66 that represents all stakeholders — everyone with dedication and passion for the Mother Road.

With this goal in mind, the Steering Committee decided to send some of its members off to travel the length of Route 66 and present the proposed ideas it had come up with via a series of meetings to which all interested parties would be invited.

The 2.5-3 hour Collaboration Workshop meetings were lively affairs, with participants actively engaged in discussing the ideas proposed by the Steering Committee.

Mr. Bill Thomas, Chair-

man of the Steering Committee, facilitated the workshops, which began with Mr. Aaron Mahr, Superintendent of the National Park Service (NPS) National Trails Intermountain Region, and Ms. Kaisa Barthuli, Program Manager, NPS Route 66 Corridor Preservation Program, providing background information on the role of NPS in its partnership with the Steering Committee, as well as a brief overview of how and why the Steering Committee was established. Those in attendance were asked for direct input regarding the ideas proposed by the Steering Committee. Participants were asked to consider a mission statement, strategic outcomes, goals, and a structure for the proposed new organization that would facilitate national collaboration amongst Route 66 stakeholders.

Specifically, the participants were asked to identify strengths/weaknesses for each idea, to list questions they had about each idea, and to offer any recommendations they might have for each idea. The participants first discussed the proposed ideas in small groups, then each small group reported out on its work. At the conclusion of each Collaboration Workshop meeting, written comments were collected from each small group so a record of stakeholder input could be collected.

Those ideas include: a mission statement, a set of strategic outcomes/goals, and a draft organizational structure for the proposed new national framework for collaboration. A complete listing of Steering Committee members can also be found at the website.

With the Collaboration Workshops completed, the Route 66: The Road Ahead Initiative Steering Committee will now:

1. Review and synthesize participant feedback from the workshops in order to write a Preliminary Report.
2. Distribute the Preliminary Report to members of the Steering Committee
3. Develop next steps based on the Preliminary Report findings
4. Produce a Final Collaboration Workshops Report to be distributed to Route 66 stakeholders which includes next steps to be taken in the process of establishing the new national framework for collaboration
5. Implement the identified next steps

The Preliminary Report to the Steering Committee will be completed by or before September 30, 2015. The Final Collaboration Workshops Report will be distributed to Route 66 stakeholders and the general public by or before November 20, 2015.

In addition to discussing proposals for a new framework for national collaboration, participants at the Collaboration Workshops were presented with the idea of designating Route 66 as a National Historic Trail. This was done because the Federal government's current involvement in, and support for, Route 66 is through the NPS Rt. 66 Corridor Preservation Program (CPP). The CPP program was originally established in 2001, then reauthorized for an additional 10 years in 2009. It is now set to expire in 2019. The Federal government could reauthorize the CPP program again, but only for another 10 years – and given the current political climate in D.C., the likelihood of reauthorization for a stand-alone program such as the CPP is slim. Accordingly, the Steering Committee decided to recommend to Route 66 Stakeholders that National Historic

Trail designation be sought for Route 66. This would result in a permanent federal designation for Route 66 that could provide many of the same functions as the CPP program. Mr. John Conoboy, a member of the Steering Committee and a retired management specialist in National Trails, was on hand at the Collaboration Workshop meetings to present background information and help facilitate the discussion regarding the proposed National Historic Trail designation for Route 66.

The response from Collaboration Workshop participants to the idea of designating Route 66 as a National Historic Trail was very positive, even though it was made clear that doing so would take time and be a challenging political process. Initial analysis of the written feedback collected from the Collaboration Workshop meetings supports the verbal comments made during the meetings when the small groups reported out on their discussions. Accordingly, the Steering Committee is moving forward with developing a plan for securing National Historic Trail designation for Route 66, so that - pending final analysis of the written comments collected from workshop participants – the committee is positioned to move forward with doing the work needed to secure this designation.

The vision is clear: the creation of a new organization focused on promoting and facilitating collaboration amongst Route 66 stakeholders. The process for achieving that vision is being planned and implemented. Everyone with an interest in and passion for Route 66 is invited to join the effort being led by the Route 66: The Road Ahead Initiative.

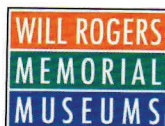
