Oklahoma Route 66 Museum to Host Route 66 Hall of Fame Induction, Route 66 Book Signing, and Route 66 Photo Exhibition Opening

CLINTON, Okla. — There will be a lot happening at this year's biannual Oklahoma Route 66 Hall of Fame Induction ceremony at the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum in Clinton, Okla., on Saturday April 28, 2018. In addition to inducting the newest hall of fame members, two other events will take place that day.

Beginning at 11 a.m., nationally known Route 66 historians and photographers Jim Ross and Shellee Graham will sign copies of their newest book, "Secret Route 66: A Guide to the Weird, Wonderful, and Obscure." This will take place in conjunction with the official opening of the museum's new "Route 66 Photo Exhibit," created by Ross and Graham and featuring 35 of their color and black and white Route 66 images.

Ross is a current Oklahoma Route 66 Hall of Fame member, and both photographers are recipients of the John Steinbeck Award for historic preservation. Ross is also a recipient of the Oklahoma Historical Society Citation of Merit. Together, Ross and Graham are the authors or co-authors of 15 books dedicated to Route 66, the most famous historic highway in America.

Beginning at 2 p.m., the Oklahoma Route 66 Association will induct two special Oklahomans into the Oklahoma Route 66 Hall of Fame. Inductions are held every two years for individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the promotion or preservation of

Route 66. The selection includes a nomination and committee process conducted by the association. The winners' plaques are displayed in the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum's Hall of Fame, located in the WOW! Exhibit Room.

The Oklahoma Route 66 Museum will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The event is open and free of charge. Attendees are invited to enjoy refreshments while listening to music that was popular when Route 66 was a main highway to travel. The event is sponsored by the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, and the Friends of the Oklahoma Route 66 Museum, Inc.

The Oklahoma Route 66 Museum is located at 2229 W. Gary Blvd. in Clinton. Regular admission is \$7 for adults, \$5 for seniors ages 62 and up, \$4 for children ages 6 to 18 and free for children under 6. The museum galleries present the history and legends of Route 66 through the decades. For additional information, please contact Pat Smith at 580-323-7866 or email rt66mus@okhistory.org.

Anyone driving Route 66 through Chandler for the last year or so could not fail to notice the construction of a mysterious structure on the east side of town, fronted by the restored 66 Bowl sign, formerly of OKC.



Recently owners Sid Hayes and Ladonna Berry offered a behind the scenes glimpse at the progress INSIDE the huge entertainment complex.

Housing a 50s style diner at the front, one of the major attractions of this new enterprise will be a classic bowling alley, with its own adjacent snack bar. Sid was able to purchase the long, slender Route 66 mural from the defunct 66 Bowl, and proudly displays it inside.



Upstairs is a sizeable Lazer Tag arena, complete with black light and urban post apocalyptic graffiti.

Decorating just about every wall downstairs is Sid's amazing collection of signs and memorabilia. Outside, the parking lot will be festooned with various classic service station brand signs, the posts for which are



already installed.



When completed, this will be a visually arresting attraction along Chandler's stretch of Mother Road.



Admiral Twin to double as flea market site beginning April 14

A Tulsa landmark, the Admiral Twin Drive-In will continue to show movies, but the property will get daytime usage with the debut of a flea market April 14.

The 918 Flea Market, which previously operated at the Rose Bowl Event Center, is relocating to the Admiral Twin for a Blake-Blake partnership. 918 Flea Market owner Blake Lund reached an agreement with Admiral Twin owner Blake Smith to stage Saturday "flea fests" at the Admiral Twin. The "flea fests" will take place from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturdays, freeing up the Admiral Twin for its primary use at night.

"It's something I have kind of always wanted to do," Smith said. "There are probably more drive-ins that do better with swap meets than with actual movies across the country. There are some that don't even show movies anymore. They just use them as swap meets. So it seems like, in a way, a no-brainer. We have got all that space during the day. We have still got a mortgage to pay, so when Blake Lund came to me, I thought, 'What a great idea.'"

Lund said he is ecstatic to start a flea market at the Admiral Twin. He said he used to drive his 1973 Volkswagen Super Beetle to the Admiral Twin as a kid.

"I love 'The Outsiders' and the history with 'The Outsiders' there," Lund said, making reference to the Admiral Twin being a filming location for a 1983 film that launched the careers of the movie's young stars.

Admission to the flea market will be free, according to Lund.

"I encourage people to bring their dogs. I want that atmosphere," he said, adding that the flea fests may include live bands, car shows and cycle shows.

Lund requested that vendors refrain from calling the Admiral Twin about booth information. He provided his number: 918-921-5900.

The Admiral Twin, which is open seasonally for movies, had its 2018 opening last week. The 918 Flea Market operated at the Rose Bowl Event Center, a former bowling alley, for three Sundays in January and one Sunday in March.
