Shamrock's Pioneer West museum in downtown held events all weekend, including the Back in the Day display, cowboy chuck-wagon breakfast, noon cookout, and old west military reenactors.

Friday and Saturday nights in Shamrock featured a Rodeo and Ranch concerts, but the big event Saturday night was the banquet and silent auction

It awaits a hearing in the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Look up S.3609 at www.congress.gov to follow its progress. Oklahoma Senator James Inhofe is a co-sponsor. HR 801 is awaiting committee hearing in the Senate as well.

On January 27, 2019, (1:30 p.m. at Mother Road Market, 1124 S. Lewis Avenue, Tulsa) will be the first quarterly meeting of the Association for 2019. Quarterly meetings are open to anyone. The most important agenda item will be election of officers and board members. Plus you can check out one of the newest additions to Tulsa's stretch of Route 66. There are many choices of cool places to eat at Mother Road Market.

Earlier, I mentioned the elections specifically because I've decided to step aside as President. LaSandra and I are planning a move back to Texas to be near our families. National Park Service Route 66 Corridor Preservation Program Grants announced

The National Park Service, Route 66 Corridor Preservation Program is pleased to announce that seven grants have been awarded for the 2018 cost-share grant cycle. The cost-share grant program provides grant assistance for eligible historic preservation, research, and educational projects related to historic Route 66. Grants are offered through an annual, competitive grant cycle. Since 2001, 146 projects have been awarded \$2.17 million with \$3.45 million in cost-share match, totaling \$5.62 million in public-private investment toward the revitalization and understanding of Route 66.

Buck Atoms Cosmic Curios

Buck Atoms Cosmic Curios on 66 is a new gift shop located at 1347 E 11th Street in Tulsa, just East of the historic Meadow Gold sign. The shop carries a variety of unique Route 66 tees and merchandise that you won't find anywhere else on the route, much of which is created by Tulsa area artists.

The store's owner, Mary Beth Babcock, is currently raising funds to have a 20 foot tall custom muffler man installed at the shop to turn the area into a Route 66 destination. The muffler man will be created by artist Mark Cline of Enchanted Sculpture Studios and will be in the likeness of Buck Atoms, the space cowboy featured on the shop's logo. Tulsa Updates

As we approach the end of 2018, the energy of Route 66 in Tulsa continues to grow. New signage has been installed on the western border of the city to help travelers stay on Historic Route 66 as they explore the former Oil Capital of the World. More signage is planned, including a series of thermoplastic shields along the pavement itself to guide out-of-towners.

Ground has been broken at the traffic circle at Admiral and Mingo, the site where Cyrus Avery's service station once stood. Soon it will be the site of a new 70-by-30 foot art installation called "Route 66 Rising" by Albuquerque artist Eric Garcia. The sculpture consists of a giant Route 66 shield partially embedded in the ground, surrounded by Art Deco-inspired rings. It will be a beautiful example of how the spirit of the Mother Road is alive and well.

Progress continues being made on other projects like a small neon sign park on the southwest side of the Cyrus Avery Memorial Bridge. A series of historic markers are being designed to tell more of Tulsa's story to our visitors. Fundraising continues for the Route 66 Experience, a project by the Route 66 Alliance to build a state-of-the-art modern interpretive center for the entire road. If you haven't been down 11th street in a while, there are many new local-owned businesses between Utica and Peoria. Buck Atom's Cosmic Curios is currently working to build a custom Muffler Man statue not far from the iconic Meadow Gold neon sign. It's an exciting time to be on Route 66 in Tulsa!

Movie Green Book Comes to Tulsa

On November 25, a large group gathered at Tulsa's classic Circle Cinema (on early Route 66 at 101 S Lewis) for a special showing of the new movie *Green Book* which chronicles the journey of an Italian driver and his African American musician client across the south during the waning days of the Jim Crow era. Fundamental to their travels was a copy of the "Negro Motorist Green Book," a vital guide to safe places for blacks to eat and sleep in those times.

Special guests at the screening were members of the Threatt family, who are working to restore and preserve the historic 1915 Threatt Station on Route 66 near Luther, OK, one of those few safe places, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Members of the Threatt family displayed copies of the various *Green Book* editions and answered questions before and after the film.

Prior to the movie, a news segment from Oklahoma City's Fox News was shown, featuring Edward Threatt talking about the importance and history of this rare roadside relic.
