down Route 66 on March 1st. He began his Walk for Peace at the Santa Monica Pier in California and crossed into Oklahoma on April 27th.

By the time Sutham left Quapaw, OK and entered the state of Kansas, he had visited with dozens of Oklahomans along the Mother Road. Several news outlets throughout the state captured his journey and talked to him about his message of world peace. Sutham reached Chicago in June and is continuing on to his destination: the Statue of Liberty in New York City.

SAPULPA IS OK!

Just after midnight on Sunday May 26, a line of severe thunderstorms caused extensive damage along the Route 66 area from Kellyville through Sapulpa and south Tulsa.

The National Weather Service reported straight-line winds over 80 mph and confirmed that two EF-1 tornados hit Sapulpa.

The storms damaged trees, powerlines and business signs throughout the city, with damage to roofs and upper brick walls in downtown, plus a collapsed warehouse.



Route 66/Mission Ave was blocked as late as Tuesday the 28th while workers replaced downed powerlines. Businesses such as the iconic Happy Burger were forced to close until their power was reconnected.

This is the storm system that dropped a deadly tornado earlier that



evening in El Reno, killing two people as it destroyed a motel and clipped a trailer park near the JCT of OK 66 and US 81.



In true Oklahoma spirit, Sapulpa went ahead with the Annual Route 66 Blowout Car Show & Festival a few days later on June 1...even while roof repairs were ongoing downtown!



This year's show, celebrating its 30th anniversary, offered something for everyone, including a well stocked car show, food booths, kid's zone and arts & craft vendors plus other business and charity and informational booths.



Your association was well represented by Executive Director Marilyn Emde and President Rhys Martin, who distributed Oklahoma Trip Guides and sold t shirts and other merchandise.

Despite extensive damage, Sapulpa remains "The Heart of Route 66."


