Progress on Route 66 Ribbon Road!!

There is progress being made on the Route 66 Ribbon Road Preservation Project!

The Ribbon Road is very unique as it is the only original 9 foot wide piece of Route 66 in the Nation. The Ribbon Road was built in 1922 and was originally Oklahoma Highway 7 until it was incorporated into Route 66 in 1926. The road still has most of its original Topeka asphalt and concrete base and curbs.

The goal is to preserve the remaining 6

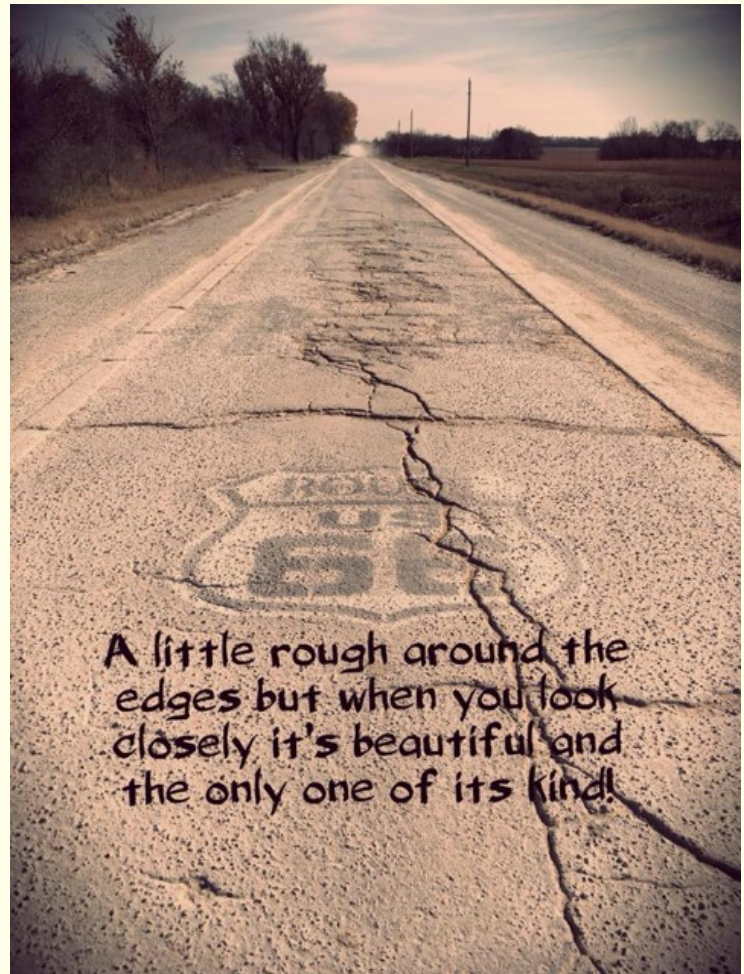

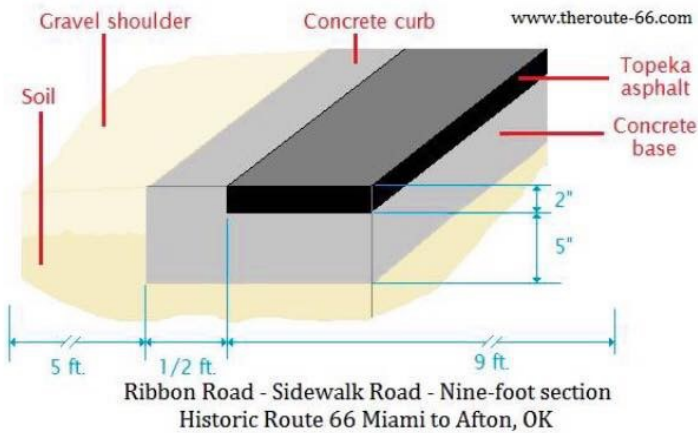

Lake Overholser Bridge along Route 66 in Oklahoma City closed for inspection, evaluation and maintenance

The Lake Overholser Bridge on NW 39th Street along historic Route 66 is closed for inspection and potential maintenance work.

Engineers performing a routine inspection Tuesday found some concerns requiring further investigation. The steel truss bridge, which opened in 1925, was restored in 2011 to accommodate pedestrians, cyclists and light vehicles.

The Public Works Department is working with the City's on-call bridge engineer to inspect and evaluate concerns observed. A timeline for the closure and maintenance will be available when the inspection is complete.

Vehicle barriers are in place at both ends of the bridge.

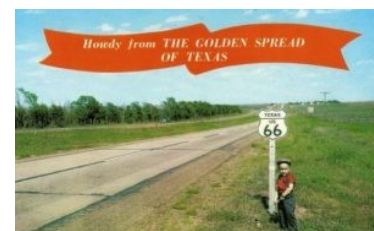

First Sign Installed using Tulsa's Neon Sign Grant

The first sign restored using the Tulsa Route 66 Commission's neon sign grant program has been lit! The grant went into effect this past April. Using part of their annual stipend from a tax package, they started offering a 50% matching grant to help pay for restoring old signs or building new ones on the city's stretch of Route 66. Billy Ray's BBQ on Southwest Boulevard was the first recipient of the grant and the first to have their work completed.

The majority of the sign is the late Billy Ray's name, as written by his mother. The neon had been dark for nearly 20 years when the family took the opportunity to have it lit once more. On Wednesday, September 4th a group of people gathered in the parking lot and counted down to Lights On. It was a joyous occasion, and the first of many in the works. Tally's Cafe is planning on expanding their neon signage at 11th and Yale in Tulsa and there are many more sign applications in various stages of approval. In a few months, 11th Street in Tulsa will have a true neon corridor to showcase the Mother Road.
